## Petition - Signature Collection

### Academics against the Introduction of Special Security Forces in Greek Universities

The period we have been going through is critical and dramatic. The Covid-19 pandemic has thrown the Greek health-system into crisis, while the strict quarantine measures have drastically affected the economy, culture and education. In this context, the academic community was suddenly informed, through vague government statements and leaks in the mass media, that the Greek government has decided to establish a new security force under the name “Squad for the Protection of Universities”. This new security force will not answer to university authorities, as required by the autonomous character of universities. Instead, it will directly fall under the Greek Police.

The Greek government intends to introduce the relevant bill next month, without any prior discussion and debate with the academic community and institutions. Moreover, it intends to employ at least 1000 police officers to be placed in universities. Both the Greek University Rectors Council and the Hellenic Federation of University Teachers’ Associations (POSDEP) have already expressed their strong objections to the forthcoming bill; yet they have not been taken into consideration not even for the sake of appearances.

This is unacceptable. We declare that we will not consent to the operation inside the University of any guard or security force not subjected to the University community control. Similarly, we consider the funding of police forces for universities profoundly provocative given the scarce resources available to Greek universities for educational purposes, research and infrastructures. That the employment of 1000 police officers for universities follows a decade of understaffing in teaching, research and administrative personnel makes this provocation all the more blatant.

It is inconceivable that in the time of a pandemic, when the universities minimally function as physical sites for education and research, the government considers the issue of university police a priority.

We urge the university authorities, unions of academic and administrative staff, as well as students not to consent to the government plans for establishing one more “security force” (what has become a standard government practice), but to make every effort to prevent it.

## Collecte des signatures

### Texte du collectif des enseignants – chercheurs contre la création d'une force de police-au sein des Universités en Grèce

Nous traversons actuellement en Grèce une période particulièrement critique à cause de la pandémie, la crise du système de santé publique et aussi des répercussions des mesures de confinement dans les domaines de l'économie, la culture et l'éducation. Au milieu de ces conditions, le monde universitaire a été stupéfait d'apprendre, via des divulgations journalistiques et des déclarations ambiguës des ministres, la décision du gouvernement d'instituer une « brigade de protection » dans les Universités.

Ce nouveau corps ne sera pas rattaché au rectorat, comme cela correspond au caractère autonome des universités, mais directement à la Police Nationale.

Le gouvernement a déjà déposé un projet de loi sur la création de ce corps, sans pour autant consulter au préalable les Universités. Il veut par ailleurs procéder au recrutement immédiat d'un millier de policiers afin de constituer ce corps de police dans les Universités. Des objections ont été avancées, aussi bien de la part de la Conférence des Présidents d'Université de Grèce, que par la Fédération des Associations des Enseignants - Chercheurs (POSDEP). Cependant, ces objections ne sont prises en compte même pas typiquement.

Nous déclarons que nous ne consentirons pas à la création, ni au fonctionnement de quelconque corps de garde ou de sécurité qui sera hors du contrôle de la Communauté Universitaire. Nous considérons que la décision de financer ce corps par le budget des Universités grecques est une provocation à un moment où les ressources pour l'éducation, la recherche et les infrastructures sont déjà minimes. Le recrutement de 1000 policiers pour les Universités, au moment où ces dernières souffrent d'une diminution des ressources et des effectifs pendant plus qu'une décennie, rend cette provocation encore plus flagrante.

Dans une période de pandémie où les Universités, espace unique de l'éducation et de la recherche, éprouvent des grandes difficultés dans leur fonctionnement, il est inconcevable que la police universitaire constitue un sujet auquel ils accordent une priorité absolue.

Nous appelons les autorités universitaires, les associations des enseignements et des chercheurs, le personnel administratif et les étudiants à dénoncer le projet gouvernemental qui vise à créer encore un « corps de sécurité », et de faire le nécessaire pour l'empêcher.
